

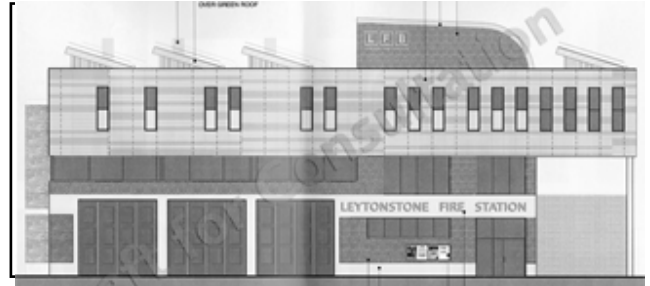

New Fire Station for Leytonstone

A new Fire Station is being proposed for Leytonstone, **Liz Phillips** and **Keith Rayner** found out recently when they visited an open evening at the Fire Station in **High Road Leytonstone**.

The London Fire Brigade were starting their consultation and discussion process with local people and interested groups, along with local ward councillors Liz and Keith.

The basic proposals are for a whole new fire station, including a third attendance pump, better public facilities, and accommodation for personnel working out of the fire station. It would also enable improved response to providing community advice on fire safety and many other areas of helpful information, without expanding its patrol area.

Focus says: "This is great news for both Cann Hall Ward and the Leytonstone area. As the plans progress, we will keep you informed of developments. You can also contact Richard Mills, Station Manager, on (020) 8555 1200 for more information."

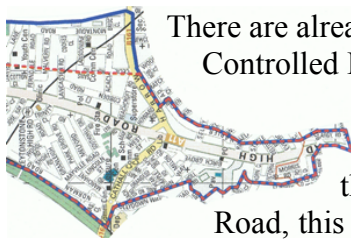

Consulting Local People First

Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) for Thatched House area



There are already proposals with local residents for a possible Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in the Thatched House area, on the Cathall side of the High Road.

Since these proposals include the junction of the High Road, Cann Hall Road and Crownfield Road, this could effect some roads in Cann Hall. In the current proposal are Eve, Steele and Belton Roads on the north side of Cann Hall Road. While on the south side are Argyle, Borthwick, Blenheim Roads could be included up to the Borough boundary at Janson Road.

Cllr Keith Rayner says: "What do you think? Many residents in these roads have complained for years about not being able to park in their own roads, due to overflow of traffic and parking from the High Road and the Thatched House area."

Keith is pushing for a full public and residents' consultation. Whatever your view please let Keith know what you think.

Fight Illegal Fly Tipping in Cann Hall

Fly tipping residents and traders who treat Cann Hall ward like a dustbin have been warned they face **huge fines** and up to five years in prison when they are caught.

Efforts to clean up the Borough are being undermined by people dumping rubbish on our streets.



Cllr Liz Phillips said: "If you have any information about fly tipping, please let us know. Our local area is being plagued by illegal fly tipping."

DISPOSE OF YOUR RUBBISH RESPONSIBLY

1. Every household can have 3 bulky waste collections a year. Contact the council to have your rubbish collected from your doorstep.
2. Take your larger waste to a household recycling centre near you.
3. The Council can provide additional black recycling boxes - go online and order one, or phone Waltham Forest Direct 8496 3000.
4. **Fly tipping is a crime - Report it!**

New Extended Alcohol Restricted Zone

A new extended Alcohol Restricted Zone was passed at Full Council on Tuesday 16th October, and will be enforced from Monday 10th November. 66% of the people consulted agreed with the Zone.

The Zone will reach from **The Green Man** roundabout in the north of Leytonstone to **Argyle Road** in the south. It runs along the **boundary of Wanstead Flats from Montague Road to Bushwood.**

Signs will be posted on lamp posts, and the enforcement will be policed by our Safer Neighbourhood Police. As they cannot be everywhere, if you see groups of people drinking in the Zone, contact either the Safer Neighbourhood Team or your ward councillors, who will pass the message on to the relevant person.
